

ACER Public Notice of 6 May 2020

ACER initiates the procedure for approval of methodologies for assessing electricity resource adequacy

On 4 May 2020, the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Electricity (ENTSO-E) submitted to ACER proposals for two methodologies in the area of resource adequacy, namely:

- Methodology for the European resource adequacy assessment pursuant to Article 23(3) of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 (ERAA, ref: ACER-ELE-2020-012); and
- Methodology for calculating the value of lost load, the cost of new entry and the reliability standard pursuant to Article 23(6) of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 (VoLL, CoNE and RS, ref. ACER-ELE-2020-013).

ACER shall approve these methodologies pursuant to Article 9(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2019/942 and Article 23(7) of Regulation (EU) 2019/943, based on the procedure set out in Article 27 of Regulation (EU) 2019/943.

In order to inform its assessment, ACER invites interested third parties to submit their observations on the methodologies during a three-week [public consultation](#), until 27 May 2020.

Following this consultation, ACER will consider stakeholder feedback and expects to take two decisions on the methodologies within the next three months as required by Article 27 of Regulation (EU) 2019/943, i.e. by 5 August 2020.
