Subject: HUAT incremental capacity project proposal - observations

Dear Sir/Madam,

with reference to the "Notice on the HUAT incremental capacity project proposal", MET Austria GmbH would like to make the following observation on the subject of the incremental capacity project proposal for the Mosonmagyaróvár interconnection point:

- we believe that any type of auction requiring system users to take binding commitments on HUAT shall take place only after the clarification of main regional projects:
 - o currently the future of Krk LNG Terminal is not decided;
 - o the ROHU Open Season is not closed, and even after that it will take time to clarify all required steps related to the sourcing from Romania towards Hungary;
 - o the HUSKAT Open Season is also ongoing which is partially a competitive route to HUAT;
 - o the continuation of the Turk Stream II is also undecided yet.
- all these projects has significant impact on the necessity of such HUAT pipeline and real market demand collection can be started after at least some of these projects are clarified.

Therefore we would suggest to hold a capacity auction for HUAT capacities only in 2020 in order that META and other system users can place bids at acceptable risk level.
