

Martin Godfried was appointed head of the Market Surveillance and Conduct department at the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators on 16 November 2016. In 2011, Martin already joined the Agency as Team Leader Policy and Market Monitoring in the Electricity Department where he was responsible for the first five editions of the annual market monitoring report of the Agency. Previously he worked at the European Commission\DG Competition (2005-2011) where he wrote several chapters in the Energy Sector Inquiry and co-delivered several energy antitrust European Commission Decisions, including a case rendering a split of the Swedish electricity transmission network. Before that he worked at the Dutch energy regulator (2001-2005), the Dutch competition authority (1998-2001) and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) in Paris (1996-1997). Martin regularly teaches on energy regulation related topics at the Florence School of Regulation.

Martin holds an MA in economics from the University of Amsterdam.
