1. Opening

1. Reporting of non-standard contracts

A technical discussion concerning the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) received by ACER continued.

2. General update on REMIT implementation

ACER provided recent updates on the REMIT implementation. ACER informed the meeting participants that the questions which the Agency had received from different stakeholders had already been or would be answered in the near future through the publication of Q&A and FAQ documents. ACER informed the meeting participants that they are keen to answer any questions. However, ACER pointed out that providing a detailed answer is not always possible, which is why most of the time a reference is made to other publicly available documentation.

ACER informed the participants that in the near future the roundtable could also discuss some policy related issues. ACER also informed the meeting participants that in order to speed up the RRM registration process, market participants should, for the time being, only use the WEB GUI interface. Once approved as RRMs, they would be able to select more interfaces and carry out more testing.

ACER informed the meeting participants that the next REMIT Public Workshop will take place on 16 February 2016.

3. Reporting of non-standard contracts

The Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) received by ACER were further technically discussed and it was agreed that the remaining questions on non-standard contracts would be discussed at the next webinar.

4. Planning next meeting

ACER informed the meeting participants that the next webinar would be carried out during the week of 15 February.

5. AOB

The participants expressed interest in the possibility of discussing transportation contracts at the roundtable. ACER indicated that they were in the process of discussing transportation and fundamental data with the ENTSOs and that it might be possible to discuss secondary capacity contracts with the roundtable participants in the future.
