



## Webinar on gas storage regulation and security of supply: ACER and CEER analyses

Tuesday, 17 May 2022 / 10.00 - 11.30 CET

## Context

The <u>REPowerEU communication</u>, published on 8 March 2022, highlights the key role gas storage plays in guaranteeing security of supply for gas consumers in these volatile times. A few days later, on 23 March 2022, the European Commission presented their <u>legislative proposal for a Regulation</u> concerning measures to safeguard the security of gas supply and on conditions for access to natural gas transmission networks. This proposal introduces a minimum of 80% gas storage level obligation by 1 November for winter 2022, rising to 90% for the years 2023 and beyond.

On 7 April, ACER published a <u>Report on National Gas Storage</u> regulations which provides an overview of the current national gas storage regulations. On 27 April 2022, CEER published a <u>Reflection Paper on the Regulation of Long-Term Energy Storage from a Sector-Coupling</u> <u>Perspective</u>, presenting a series of case studies from seven different Members States. And lastly, ACER and CEER jointly published a <u>note on the Commission proposal to revise the gas SoS and gas</u> <u>storage Regulation</u> on 29 April 2022, summarising regulators' views on the revised EU rules for storage regulation. ACER and CEER contribute with these three documents to the current discussions on new policies for filling storages next winter.
