Workshop Objective: Important developments in the policies of decarbonisation of the European Union (EU) energy and transport sectors have taken place since the development of the first European grid connection network codes (GC NCs) in 2012.

In the framework of the Grid Connection European Stakeholder Committee, the European Commission proposed that the EU Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER) initiates the process to amend the existing European GC NCs in September 2022.

ACER is organising a hybrid workshop on 25 October on the amendment to the GC NCs. This workshop is organised in the context of the public consultation on the same topic, which runs from 26 September to 21 November 2022. With this public consultation, ACER is gathering stakeholders' views and concrete amendment proposals regarding the two GC NCs: the Network Code on Requirements for Grid Connection of Generators and the Network Code on Demand Connection. Stakeholders may submit their comments to one or both GC NCs separately.

The objective of this public workshop is to hear stakeholders' proposals for amendment of the GC NCs. ACER invited EU associations to present the key areas in which they intend to send proposals for amendments in the public consultation.

In this public workshop, ACER intends to:

- Discuss with stakeholders the key areas for amendments that stakeholders intend to submit in the course of the public consultation; and
- provide any necessary clarifications on the purpose, process and timeline for the amendments.
