Thank you for your email and the draft Framework Scenario Guidelines. We would like to comment on the draft as follows:

(31) We ask to include the following new bullet to the list in order to represent the growing importance of hybrid offshore wind projects connected to more than one bidding zone: “- the extent of hybrid offshore wind projects”.

(38) Scenarios should be developed for the (very) long-term perspective until 2050 as well. It is important to consider long-term trajectories, in particular with a view to the long-term nature of grid expansion projects. Subsequent scenarios and TYNDPs may provide for necessary adjustments.

(43) Member States should also be allowed to become observers to the SRG.
