

DIRECTOR DECISION 2024-25

of 6 December 2024

on the appointment of Confidential Counsellors

THE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR THE COOPERATION OF ENERGY REGULATORS,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2019/942 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 June 2019 establishing a European Union Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators¹, and, in particular, Article 24(1e) thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union (“Staff Regulations”) and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union (“CEOS”), laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68²,

Having regard to the Decision AB No 06/2017 of the Administrative Board of the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators of 16 March 2017 on the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators’ policy on protecting the dignity of the person and preventing psychological harassment and sexual harassment and, in particular, point 6.2 and 6.3 of the Annex thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) On 18 March 2024, the European Union Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”) launched a Call for expression of interest for the selection of Confidential Counsellors at the Agency.
- (2) Following the selection of the applicants, four (4) candidates received compulsory training for confidential counsellors in the course of the last quarter of 2024.
- (3) The four (4) candidates that are to be appointed on a voluntary basis were confirmed by the trainers to possess the necessary skills and knowledge to be appointed confidential counsellors,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

- (1) The following staff members are hereby appointed Confidential Counsellors of the European Union Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (‘ACER’) and the inter-agency network:
 - Ms. Valeria STALTARI (TA, AST4)
 - Ms. Julia HENTZ (TA, AST3)
 - Ms. Monique WIZA (CA FGIV17)
 - Ms. Tjasa PERENIC HONN (CA FGIV15)

- (2) The term of office of the confidential counsellor shall be two years and may be renewed twice.
