## ACER-ELE-2024-005

The European Union Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER) initiates the procedure ref. ACER-ELE-2024-005 to decide on the deadline for Autoriteit Consument & Markt (ACM), the Dutch National Regulatory Authority (NRA), to reach coordinated decisions with the Norwegian NRA (NVE-RME), on cross-zonal risk hedging opportunities under Article 30(2) of Commission Regulation (EU) 2016/1719 of 26 September 2016 establishing a guideline on forward capacity allocation

On 18 February 2024, ACM submitted to ACER a request to extend the deadline to decide on the above-mentioned matter by six months. The request is submitted pursuant to Article 6(10) subparagraph 3 of Regulation (EU) 2019/942.

ACER intends to decide on this request in an expedited manner, aiming to reach a decision in April 2024.

The EFTA Surveillance Authority (ESA) will decide on the NVE-RME extension request based on a draft from ACER, in accordance with the Third Energy Package as outlined in the EEA Agreement.
