

ACER initiates procedure ref. ACER-ELE-2022-014 for approval pursuant to Articles 9(6)(i) and 9(13) of Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222

On 15 September 2022, the Nominated Electricity Market Operators (NEMOs) submitted to ACER the following proposals for approval pursuant to Articles 9(6)(i) and 9(13) of Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222:

- All NEMOs' proposal for the Harmonised Maximum and Minimum Clearing Price methodology for Single Day-Ahead Coupling, pursuant to Article 41 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222, and,
- All NEMOs' proposal for the Harmonised Maximum and Minimum Clearing Price methodology for Single Intraday Coupling, pursuant to Article 54 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222.

According to Article 9(10) of Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222, ACER has until the 15 March 2023 to decide on these proposals. However, due to the extraordinary market circumstances, ACER aims to conclude the process much faster.

In order to inform its assessment, ACER invites interested parties to submit their observations on the NEMOs' proposals via ACER's [public consultation](#), which runs from 19 September to 9 October 2022.

Furthermore, ACER organises a public workshop on 3 October to provide clarifications on the purpose, process and content of the draft proposals on the revision of the rules defining the maximum and minimum clearing prices of the day-ahead and intraday electricity markets in the run-up to the decision.
