

## **DECISION No 6/2018**

# OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE AGENCY FOR THE COOPERATION OF ENERGY REGULATORS

### of 7 June 2018

## on the adoption by analogy of the

'Guide to missions and authorized travel accompanying the Commission Decision on the general provisions for implementing Articles 11, 12 and 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of Officials (mission expenses) and on authorised travel'

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE AGENCY FOR THE COOPERATION OF ENERGY REGULATORS.

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 713/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 July 2009 establishing an Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators<sup>1</sup>,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union ('CEOS'), laid down originally by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68², and, in particular, Articles 71 and 110 of the Staff Regulations and Articles 11 to 13a of Annex VII thereto and Articles 22 and 92 of the CEOS,

Having regard to Commission Decision C(2008) 6215 of 18 November 2008 adopting the Guide to Missions for officials and other servants of the European Communities,

Having regard to Commission Decision C(2017) 5323 of 27 September 2017 on the general provisions for implementing Articles 11, 12 and 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of Officials (mission expenses) and on authorised travel and its Annex, 'Guide to missions and authorized travel',

Having regard to Decision No 09/2011 of the Administrative Board of the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators of 1 June 2011 on the adoption of implementing rules to the Staff Regulations, and, in particular, Annex 16 thereof,

After consulting the Staff Committee on 23 February 2018,

## Whereas:

(1) On 2 October 2017, pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations, the Commission informed the Agency on the new 'Guide to mission and authorized travel' annexed to Commission Decision C(2017) 5323 which was adopted, as implementing rules to the Staff Regulations, on 27 September 2017, entered into force on the day following its adoption, 28 September 2017, and takes effect six months after its adoption (27 March

- 2018). In application of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations and in absence of derogation, these implementing rules, should apply by analogy to the Agency by the decision of the Administrative Board within nine months upon the date of notification,
- (2) Commission Decision C(2017) 5323 repealed the previous decision on missions, Commission Decision C(2008) 6215. The new Commission Decision takes effect six months after its adoption, as of 27 March 2018. Therefore, the provisions of Commission Decision C(2008) 6215 remain in application until 27 March 2018.
- (3) Annex 16 of Decision No 09/2011 of the Administrative Board of the Agency of 1 June 2011 adopting Commission Decision C(2008) 6215, should be repealed by the present decision,

#### HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

#### Article 1

Commission Decision C(2017) 5323 on the general provisions for implementing Articles 11,12 and 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of Officials (mission expenses) and on authorised travel as adopted by the Commission on 27 September 2017 and entered into force on 28 September 2017 shall apply by analogy to the staff of the Agency.

#### Article 2

Annex 16 of Decision No 09/2011 of the Administrative Board of the Agency, concerning the application by analogy Commission Decision C(2008) 6215, is hereby repealed.

## Article 3

The provisions of 'Guide to mission and authorized travel' annexed to Commission Decision C(2017) 5323 shall take effect as of 2 July 2018. The previous rules on mission, as adopted by Annex 16 of Decision No 09/2011 of the Administrative Board of the Agency, shall remain in application until 1 July 2018.

#### Article 4

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
