During her time in RAE she worked extensively on natural gas regulation indicatively in the development of access conditions for gas transmission, distribution and LNG and also in the exemptions of new infrastructure (e.g. TAP, IGB). She left RAE in 2015 and in the period 2015-2021 she worked as an energy expert, advising companies and consortiums mainly on implementation of the overall EU legal and regulatory energy framework. She is now Managing Director and Country Manager for Greece of Energean Oil and Gas S.A. a subsidiary of Energean Plc an independent E&P company active mainly in the Mediterranean and also the Managing Director of EnEarth Greece, the new vehicle of Energean for the development of sustainability investments. She is currently leading the development of Prinos CO₂, the first storage of CO₂ in the north east mediterranean.</i></p>
