An economist and energy expert, Bart is the acting head of the Market Information and Transparency department of the EU Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER).

Before taking up this role in February 2024, for the previous four year, Bart led the EU Agency's Strategy Delivery and Communications team. In that capacity, he worked directly with the Director of the Agency and senior management team on strategic and communication matters, as well as energy related outreach.

Bart joined the Agency in 2015 as Policy and Market Monitoring Team Leader where he was responsible for the annual Market Monitoring Report of the Agency focusing on gas wholesale markets, retail and customer protection and empowerment aspects.

Prior to joining ACER, Bart worked for McKinsey & Company as an energy expert/project manager, chiefly on electricity and gas regulatory design issues across the value chain covering Europe, Africa and Southeast Asia as well as on market research/intelligence of European energy markets.
