Karin Lunning is the Head of the Market Surveillance and Conduct Department of the European Union Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER) as from 16 January 2025. Before starting this operative role, Karin served as a full member of the Administrative Board of ACER during 2019-2023 and as an alternate member during 2023-2024.

Karin started her career in the Swedish court system and was thereafter active in the competition law field for over 25 years, particularly at the Swedish Competition Authority (SCA). At the SCA she held various senior positions including Deputy Director General but also Acting Director General, Head of International Affairs and Senior Adviser to the Director General. Her international experience included coordinating and upholding the SCA's cooperation with international agencies and organizations on issues related to competition and public procurement. It also included the authority's collaboration with other national competition authorities within the EU. Relating to Karin's international experience, Karin has lived for several years in Asia, where she worked on various international competition assignments including organizing OECD capacity-building events.

Karin has a Master of Law from Stockholm University.
