

UPDATE - LATVIA

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- GDP 9 months of 2011 versus 9 months of 2010 – increase by 5.4%
- Electricity consumption:
 11 months of 2011 versus 11 months of 2010 – decrease by 1.8%
- Gas consumption
 11 months of 2011 versus 11 months of 2010 – decrease by 8.0%



The amendment to the Electricity Market Law entered into force 11August, 2011

Latvia has chosen unbundling model of independent system operator (IS0)

New company - owner of transmission assets has been established in April 4, 2011.

Approved new management board of ISO.

The final procedure about transfer of shares of ISO - SC "Augstsprieguma tīkls" has to be taken within some weeks

Regulatory independence



- Regulatory law, which determines status of regulator has been amended and is fully in line with the requirements of the 3-rd EC energy legislative package
- Our Parliament adopted Regulatory law and it entered into force in August, 11 2011



The Energy law has been changed in October 2011 and simplify start up of trade and production activities in heat and electricity sectors.

The licensing of power and heat generation and sales activities is substituted by registration.

Registration is taking effect form 1 January 2012

All company which held licenses prior to Jaunary1, 2012 were registered automatically.

Regulator elaborated document setting provisions to be fulfilled by applicants.

Latest changes - legal acts



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Regulator at the end of 2011 adopted set of new legal acts about:

- 10 year development plans and planning procedure;
- TSO certification requirements and procedure.

Drafted regulations about:

Requirement to traders on disclosure of information in their bills issued to customers.



Market opening:

- All customer are free to chose their supplier from 2007.
- Government passed decision to decrease eligibility threshold for captive market customers
- All with installed tripping device above 100A become market participants.
- From April 1, 2012 additional 4500 electricity customer will become market participants.
- Opening will reach close to 80% of inland consumption.



- From April 1, 2011 new electricity tariffs for end users are in force with average increase of ~ 21%
- Gas tariffs alters in line with prices of oil/ oil product in the world markets, increased from January 1, 2012 ~10-20%
- set up of heat tariffs depends on the fluctuation of price of gas or wood chips
- Energy arrears are becoming an important issue, especially in the heating sector

Adopt TSO 10 years investment plan

Carry out Certification of TSO

Adopt changes in the Grid Code
