ACER Role and Process

The European Network Codes aim to contribute to the objectives of the 3rd Energy Package, in particular, non-discrimination, effective competition and the efficient functioning of the market.

ACER's role as set out in Regulation (EC) No 714/2009, Art 6(7)-(9):

- Provide a reasoned opinion to ENTSO-E on the compliance of the Network Code with the Framework Guidelines.
- When the Agency is satisfied that the Network Code is in line with the Framework Guidelines, the Agency shall submit it to the Commission and may recommend that it be adopted.

Process:

ACER has received broad-ranging comments from the majority of EU
NRAs assessing the implications of the RfG at a national level.



Purpose of the workshop

- Consult with stakeholders to hear their views on:
 - i) changes made to the Network Code following the public consultation and the justification provided;
 - ii) how and where the Network Code meets or deviates from the Framework Guidelines.
- The development process of the Network Code is monitored by ACER in line with our monitoring competencies (Article 9 Regulation (EC) No 714/2009), but cannot be the basis for ACER's opinion on the Network Code.
