

# NATIONAL UPDATE – ROMANIA ENTRY-EXIT MODEL AND VTP

"Implementation of EU Gas Market Rules with Focus on Network Codes in the Romanian Gas Market" Workshop, in Bucharest, 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> of June 2017

### Workshop main conclusions:

- Transgaz to provide a proposal for NC amendment in order to facilitate for the network users the possibility to submit trade notifications without quantity limits on the VTP;
- With the full implementation of the entry exit model, the access to the VTP will be without any restrictions on any users
   Note: The entry exit system containing fully decoupled entry exit contracts with corresponding tariffs including the DSO level requires a more complex approach;
- Transgaz to propose to ANRE to change the gas day to 7 to 7
   Romanian time in line with the CAM Network Code;
- ANRE shall set or approve and publish the methodology for the calculation of the neutrality charges, based on Article 30 (2) of the Balancing NC.



**September 2017** – within the margin of CESEC Ministerial Meeting, in Bucharest, 27<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> of September 2017:

- Considering the challenges the market rules implementation/sector reform in Romania is facing – proposal to establish an Working Group on Romanian gas market design, with the aim of:
  - i) defining/agreeing on the detailed the entry-exit regime design (weighing e.g. specificities of the Romanian gas sector versus experiences in other Member States) on which basis and as part of which
  - ii) the specific features of the network codes (e.g. daily balancing) can be introduced into the system.
- WG participants: DGENER, ACER, ENTSOG, ANRE, TRANSGAZ;
- WG set up in first half of October 2017;



### ✓ Established in October 2017, with the participation of:











#### **SCOPE:**

To check the compliance of current Romanian gas market regulatory framework with the applicable European laws and to establish specific concepts/recommendations for amending the national secondary laws or other applicable regulations.



#### WG activities:

- Inform stakeholders about WG establishment and request detailed concepts for the Romanian gas regulatory framework – feedback by 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2017;
- 1<sup>st</sup> WG meeting on entry exit system design and governance 16<sup>th</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> of November 2017 - Bucharest;
- Develop entry-exit concept and governance + use cases on VTP and other open issues from 1<sup>st</sup> working group – by 5<sup>th</sup> of December 2017;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> WG meeting on network codes 11<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> of December 2017 Brussels;
- Develop concepts for NC implementation by Mid-February 2018;
- Stakeholder meeting to discuss holistic concept (entry-exit, NCs, governance) – 22<sup>nd</sup> of March 2018;
- Revise concepts as necessary Mid-April 2018;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> WG meeting to finalise technical concepts 25<sup>th</sup> of April 2018;
- Final version of the Concept Paper 18<sup>th</sup> of May 2018
- Feedback from the working group (EC, ACER, ENTSOG) 25<sup>th</sup> of May 2018
- Start of regulatory procedures to formalise the Concept Paper June 2018;
- Fully operational entry-exit system with all NCs implemented and IT systems ready – 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2019.



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
