ACER background information

The Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER) was established by the Third Package. As an EU Agency, ACER fosters cooperation among European Energy Regulators to promote energy market integration and harmonisation of regulatory frameworks across the European Union, to deliver:

- a more competitive, integrated market which offers consumers more choice;
- an efficient energy infrastructure guaranteeing the free movement of energy across borders and the transportation of new energy sources, thus enhancing security of supply for EU businesses and consumers; and
- integrity and transparency in the energy market guaranteeing fair and cost-reflective prices for consumers, as well as deterrence of abusive practices.

The Agency is headed by its Director, Alberto Pototschnig, and comprises five departments and three Boards (the Administrative Board, the BoR and the Board of Appeal).
