NC on IPs between EU and EnC TSOs

- Reasons for this topic
 - Significant natural gas flow on these IPs, especially from Ukraine
 - Legal gap for NC implementation on IPs between EU and EnC TSOs
 - To compare practice on these IPs during long term transmission contract and after expiration (some will expire soon)
 - To check if rules on new IPs between EU and EnC TSOs will be in line with NC
- Task of the project
 - Basic layer of monitoring
 - Determine actual practise on IPs between SSE EU and EnC TSOs
 - Point to possible difficulties in implementation
 - Make recommendations about necessary steps for NC implementation on IPs between SSE EU and EnC TSOs

- Information was required from NRA
- EU Poland, Slovakia, Hungary, Romania, Bulgaria, Greece, Italy
- EnC Ukraine, Moldova, Serbia, North Macedonia, Albania

- Is IA content in line with NC INT
- Aplicable units and referent conditions
- Gas quality and odourisation
- Data exchange types, data solutions and security measures

Questionnaire - 2

NC BAL

Nomination, rejection of nomination and re-nomination at IPs

NC CAM

- TSOs cooperation
- Allocation of firm capacity
- Incremental capacity process
- Interruptible capacity

NC TAR

- The values from cost allocation assessment
- Level of multipliers and seasonal factors
- Price formation for bundled capacity and capacity at virtual IPs
- Clearing price and payable price

Timelines for the questionnaire and Report

- Timeline for the questionnaire
 - The first version 19 July 2019 was sent to ACER review
 - The second version was sent to NRA for comments 15 September 2019
 - The final version was sent to NRA for fulfillment 8 October 2019
 - Deadline for NRA to collect data from their TSOs and send fulfiled questionnaire was 8 November 2019
 - Only Poland and Serbia sent fulfiled questionnaire until now
 - Appeal to other TSOs and NRA to send fulfilled questionnaire asap
- Timeline for the report
 - The first version February 2020 will be sent to ACER review
 - The second version will be presented to SH on the GRI SSE meeting – spring 2020
 - The final report about NC implementation on IPs between EU and EnC TSOs – June 2020

- Sources for information about NC implementation
 - The questionnaire for practice on IPs between EU and EnC TSOs and
 - ACER reports about practice on IPs between EU TSOs
 - ECRB EnC reports about practice on IPs between EnC TSOs

Report

- Practice on IPs between EU TSOs as a base how to implement NC on IPs between EU and EnC TSOs
- Practice on IPs between EnC TSOs as a check if NC implementation started in EnC
- Report recommendation for IPs between EU and EnC TSOs
 - maybe in more than one steps implementation on the same IPs
 - the same solutions on both side of IP
 - the same solutions on all IPs in one country, if it is possible

Possible results from NC implementation

- NC implementation on EU-EnC IPs in EnC TSOs
 - simplified shippers entrance on EnC countries gas markets
 - will help in development of wholesale gas market in EnC countries
 - competition reduces gas price for final customers
 - experience for NC implementation on EnC-EnC IPs

- NC implementation on EU-EnC IPs in EU TSOs
 - positive impact on wholesale gas market in EU countries
 - promotion of regional gas market
