Who is EFETnet?

- EFETnet is not-for-profit, self financing and 100% controlled by the European Federation of Energy Traders (EFET)
- EFETnet takes open standards – processes and data – developed by EFET, and delivers:
 - An IT infrastructure for the commodity trading industry
 - Central self maintained community data, forums and resources
 - Multiple process automation through centrally hosted SAAS modules
 - Central testing, security and support services
 - Cost sharing of standardised processes developed by the industry for the industry




EFETnet's Regulatory Reporting History

- electronic Regulatory Reporting, eRR, is the response to a growing operational need to comply with regulatory reporting obligations
- Live since 2012, EFETnet's eRR provides a single universal interface for reporting regulatory data independent of geography or consumer. eRR provides support for
 - Commodities reporting under Dodd-Frank
 - Commodities, Interest Rates and Foreign Exchange reporting under EMIR
 - REMIT reporting launching in October 2015 – EFETnet was approved as an RRM on 24 July in the first group of approved RRMs
- Benefits of eRR
 - Automates the regulatory reporting process for MPs and OMPs
 - Standardised formats and processes for reporting, regardless of repository or regime



Next Steps for REMIT

- Continue RRM testing extensively with ACER
 - Still seeing unpredictable behaviour from ARIS, working with ACER to flag and resolve
- Connect up OMPs
 - More than 20 OMPs are connected to eRR with more to come before go-live
- Connect up MPs
 - More than 70 groups have signed (representing over 300 MPs) taking advantage of RRM services for free
 - It's not too late – as an MP you can have read access with no IT work on your end where you can track all your EU reporting in one place
- Connect to NRAs
 - REMIT reporting is live with eControl (Austria) now
 - Work underway for ECom (Switzerland)
- Prepare for October 7
 - eRR for REMIT live on October 1 – clarifying backloading approaches with MPs now
- REMIT Phase 2 implementation under way
